When airlines or militaries upgrade their aviation fleets, the outdated planes are sent to places called "airplane graveyards." The largest such graveyard in the United States is the Davis Monthan Air Force Base in Arizona, known to local residents and military personnel as the "Boneyard." More than 4,400 military aircraft, ranging from cargo planes to fighter jets, are lined up in orderly, grave-like rows in the desert there, and their usable parts are removed and recycled for use in active duty planes at air bases around the world. Some Boneyard planes are even fixed up and used again. For example, a B52 bomber laid to rest in 2008 was upgraded and returned to military service in 2015. Others have been upgraded but are kept on standby for use as needed.
